

## Message to Members ---

Dear Fellow UCC Members,

As the 2007-08 curling season drew to a close, the UCC Board had clearly identified the top three sources of revenue the Utica Curling Club needed to strengthen in order to keep our fiscal ship afloat. These three major revenue opportunities were:

- major events hosted by the UCC
- sponsorship and advertising
- membership dues

As your new President, these three areas created strategic goals around which the summer has revolved. I am certain these three areas will continue to guide and shape our collective efforts as the curling season unfolds; here's a summary of our efforts to date:

### Major Events:

The UCC's 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Golf Tournament in June, as well as the August Garage Sale and Chicken BBQ were all major non-curling events held over the summer. Together these events raised approximately \$10,000 for the club. Thanks to the many people who helped to make these events happen. All were major undertakings, with great leaders shouldering the effort. If you see any of the Golf Tourney Committee (Tom Thorngren, Anne Stuhlman, Barb Felice, Don Knapp, Jim Shaffer, Brenda or Phil Citriniti, Knyoka or Conrad Law) tell them they hit a "hole in one"! Without them, the organization and execution of this complex event would never have happened. Hooray for our wonderful volunteers!

Looking ahead to the season to come, the board has actively sought and been awarded a number of special curling events. Chief among these is the USCA’s Club Nationals in March. We will also be hosting the GNCC’s Men’s Five and Under Bonspiel, the USCA’s Wheelchair Trials and an International Wheelchair Bonspiel. The GNCC’s Junior Playdowns are also scheduled. As always, the Mitchell and the Cobb bonspiels will add additional revenue. Volunteers are needed for all events – and we all know that many hands make light work. The chairs of these events will be looking for volunteers. Be ready to say “yes, I can” when asked.

Sponsorships and Advertising Opportunities:

Led by Dean Kelly as chair, a Sponsorship/Advertising Committee has been formed. Dean has been ably assisted by Joyce Shaffer as mailing coordinator. As this committee grows in numbers and strengthens its message, mission and community outreach, it is expected that the results will be significant. If you have not yet seen the new brochure which outlines UCC’s advertising and sponsorship opportunities, contact Dean for a copy. It is an outstanding piece and sure to be very helpful as the campaign unfolds.

Membership:

Carol Jones returns as our club’s Membership Committee Chair. She is assisted by her R2D2 Committee (that stands for Recruitment, Retention, Development and Demographics, by the

## **Wanted: New Curling Instructors**

Instructing new curlers can be a rewarding experience. It builds confidence and enjoyment of the game for those we teach, and is important in membership retention and satisfaction. And for the instructors, it is satisfying to see our new curlers progress and enjoy the sport, and is a great way to contribute to the club. You may even find that instructing reinforces practices that will help your own game.

*Curling instruction activities.* “Try Curling” is a 2 hour introduction to the sport of curling, in which prospective members are introduced to the game. “Learn to Curl” is a 3 hour crash course in curling that provides enough instruction for new curlers to get started in their chosen leagues. The “Our House is Your House” bonspiel is a chance to show new curlers what the full bonspiel experience is like, including in-game (and after-game) situations. Finally, “Curling School” is a more in-depth 7-week introduction to curling, including more advanced topics as well as more detailed work on delivery, and supervised practice games. We need qualified instructors to help make all these activities successful.

*How do I get involved in instruction?* Funny you should ask. This year the Utica Curling Club will host a U.S. Curling Association (USCA) Level I Instructors Clinic on Saturday, October 11, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. (Lunch will be provided for a small fee, or bring your own.) This clinic, which is organized by USCA Certified Level II instructors Roger Rowlett and Mary Jane Walsh, is designed to teach you how to instruct new curlers, using the most effective current practices endorsed by the USCA. Everyone who completes the course will become a USCA Registered Level I instructor, and can earn certification by participating in some instructional activities during the 2008-2009 season. The clinic is open to anyone who is interested in instructing new curlers. If you have curled only a year, you are not only welcome, but encouraged to attend. If you are a long-time curler or something in-between, you are likewise encouraged to come and learn the latest instructional methods.

The bad news is that the clinic registration fee is \$50. But, we have a deal for you! If you attend the clinic and become a USCA registered Level I instructor, and participate as an instructor in selected events (see coupon), the Utica Curling Club will refund half of your registration fee. Yes, that's right, our clinic will cost half as much as clinics that are twice as expensive! And participation in the designated instructional events will satisfy your certification requirements in short order. Seriously, we hope that many of you will consider attending, becoming registered instructors, and participating in our many new curler instructional events. And if you are interested, you can also gain Level II instructor registration the same weekend by attending a USCA Level II instructor clinic at the Schenectady Curling Club on Sunday, October 12.
